VBS – Important Information

Drop off/Pick up – Drop off begins at 8:45 each day and pick up is at noon. Only parents or persons designated by a parent or guardian, are allowed to pick up children. Drop off and pick up of children will occur at the door with the ramp behind the left side of the church. There will be signs to guide you. You will be given a return slip each day with the name(s) of the children you bring to VBS. You will need this slip to pick the children up at the end of the day.

Shoes: If possible, please have children wear closed toe shoes with rubber soles every day for their safety. No flip-flops.

Sunscreen: Weather permitting, we do take the children outside every day. You may want to apply sunscreen before dropping them off.

Accessories: Please do not send purses, toys, jewelry, etc. to VBS with your child. These types of things often get lost or broken and are hard for the VBS staff to keep track of.

Snacks: A snack will be provided to children each day. A list of what snacks are going to be given out each day can be provided on the first day of VBS. In case of a medical condition, parents may provide an alternative snack for their child. This snack will be stored in the kitchen and delivered to the child at snack time with the other children. Please label the snack with the child's name.

Preschool Requirement: Children must be toilet trained to attend VBS.

Health & Medication Policy: At Vacation Bible School we strive to provide a clean, healthy environment for your child. We make sure all bathrooms are cleaned daily and that children wash their hands after using the bathroom. We ask you to please keep a sick child at home. No one wants to share an illness.

If your child is exhibiting symptoms of diarrhea or vomiting the child is not able to attend VBS until they are free of symptoms for 24 hours.

If your child has a fever, please keep them at home. A fever is defined as a temperature of 100 degrees F or greater.

If your child is exhibiting symptoms of a highly contagious illness (pink eye, rashes, lice) while attending VBS, they will be isolated, and the parents will be contacted.

If your child becomes ill while with us, we will contact the parent or emergency contact on the registration form to pick up the child.

We ask that parents or guardians administer any medication to children prior to bringing them to VBS.

VBS will administer simple basic first aid in the case of scratches and minor scrapes.

Medications, EpiPens: If your child has a special medical condition, please feel free to contact me (Wendi Davis) at 446-3787 prior to the first day of VBS so we can work out a plan. Inhalers and other medication that may be needed by a child should be labeled and handed in at the registration desk each day of VBS.

Preregistration: If possible, please preregister your children. It is very helpful for us to know that your children are coming so we can prepare the best possible experience for them. However, it is also completely acceptable to register on the first day of VBS.
